Dr Vergis is a Consultant Clinical Oncologist, specializing in skin cancer, lymphomas and genitourinary cancers. He is currently an Honorary Consultant in Clinical Oncology at the Mount Vernon Cancer Centre, London. His professional experience includes practice at academic teaching hospitals in the United Kingdom and India as a consultant oncologist.

Dr Vergis obtained his basic medical qualification in 1995 from Medical College, Trivandrum. He trained and subsequently worked as a Consultant Clinical Oncologist and Lecturer in Radiotherapy at the Regional Cancer Centre, Trivandrum, India. He obtained further training in oncology at the Royal Marsden Hospital, London and Sutton which included 3 years in clinical cancer research with the Academic Urology Unit and Section of Molecular Carcinogenesis at the Institute of Cancer Research, Sutton. He was previously Consultant in Clinical Oncology at the Kent Oncology Centre, Maidstone and Canterbury. Dr Vergis has published peer reviewed articles as first author in Lancet Oncology, the Red Journal and the Journal of Clinical Oncology and has contributed a book chapter in the Textbook of Medical Oncology in 2004. He received the ASCO Merit Award in 2007 and 2008 and is a member of ASCO, ESTRO and the UK Melanoma Focus Group.

His academic clinical practice includes participating in cancer clinical research as principal investigator and co-investigator in multiple skin and genitourinary oncology clinical trials. He has been active in teaching oncology trainees at the Mount Vernon Cancer Centre, London. Over his 21 years in clinical and radiation oncology, he has demonstrated leadership in quality and service improvements in healthcare and experience in international health systems and cancer research.
